OUTDOOR LEARNING

We will be continuing to access the outdoor learning area down at the local Forest School site this year. These visits will be in blocks of sessions throughout the year for each class, sticking to Thursday afternoons so lunchtimes will not be affected. Dates for all classes are on the "diary dates" at the end of the newsletters. Children will need to bring appropriate clothing on these dates to change into, as the area is left totally wild. Wellies are ideal and long trousers and long sleeved tops are essential to protect from brambles, stingers and insects. Enough clothing to keep warm and coats are essential on these dates.
