## Science

'On Safari': we will be searching for and studying invertebrate during Outdoor Learning and Science lessons this term. We will closely observe invertebrates as well as ask and answer questions. We will be taking close-up photographs and sketching bugs, noticing details to improve our Science understanding of animals.






## Art/DT

In art, we will be looking at the colours the seasons bring and taking photos linked to other subjects. In Design and Technology, we will be learning how to join fabric in order to make puppets.




## English


In English, we will have daily phonics practice to improve reading and writing skills. Adult led reading groups will take place three times a week. During English lessons, we will be reading 'Outdoor Wonderland'. We will be looking at both the information text and instructions that the book contains and doing some of the suggested activities during outdoor learning afternoons. We will be writing our own information and instructions. Later in the term, we will be writing poetry and stories.



## RE, PSHE and Music



In RE, we will be continuing to learn about the beliefs of Muslims. We will learn about the importance of the Qur'an and prayer. In PSHE, we will learn about how to get on with each other, about feelings and valuing differences in our topic on relationships. We will be learning to play the Ocarina in Music. We will continue to appreciate our 'Music of the week'.

## Computing


We will be planning and taking photographs during outdoor learning. We will think about zooming in close in order to notice nature's details as well as learning to edit photos and creating photograph collages.


## PE/Games

**Line Dancing** PE: we will be learning simple line-dancing moves and putting these together to perform a line-dance to music.

**Games**: we will be taking part in 'Team Challenges' - learning to work together and developing team skills.



## Geography





We will be studying the large water village of Kampong Ayer in Asia and asking the key question – How does Kampong Ayer compare with where we live? We will be looking at and comparing location, home, weather, travel, school and natural environment.

## History key questions:


How do our favourite toys and games compare to those of children of the 1960s?  
 Why were there no SMART toys and games in the 1960s?  
 How can we make sure we play with SMART toys and games safely and securely?  
 What do adults I know remember about the 1960s? (visit from someone who was a child in 1960s).

## Mathematics

In maths this term, we will be learning about money – identifying coins and notes, counting money (£ and p), using different coins to make the same amount and finding change. We will also learn about multiplication and division – making equal groups, understanding arrays and related symbols ( $x \div =$ ). We will learn multiplications facts and how these relate to division.
