#### **Dear Parents**

We have exciting news! The Pipits' classroom is finally being replaced; the County Council have decided that we are now a priority. The new building will be on the same footprint as the existing building and will incorporate a large learning space and a smaller group space, toilets and some storage. There will be a carpeted area and a wet area to allow for the full range of class activities. The outdoor canopy round the back will also be replaced with a full length covered area with a ramped access.

The current building will be demolished in May half term and the whole area will be completely fenced off for safety. The new building can then be erected on the same site. They will be digging up areas of the playground for utilities so we will have to ensure that certain areas are cleared so that they can carry out the work unhindered. We may well be asking for a few parent helpers to move things like the new sheds, the little house, the Pipits bike shed etc, between Easter and May half term. The new build is planned to be completed ready for the new academic year, September 2024.

During this time between May half term and the summer holidays, Pipits class will be making use of the facilities at The Beacon Baptist Church. We have had meetings with the management team over there and will be making further plans over the coming weeks. Of course there will be lots of implications for the whole school and lots of planning and hard work, but we are very excited about this new phase.

As we clear out various areas in advance of the move we will undoubtedly come across a lot of stuff that will need to be disposed of and would be most grateful if anyone is able to take items to the recycling centres for us.

#### **KINGFISHERS**

Kingfisher class thoroughly enjoyed their outdoor learning session this week – they went on a safari bug hunt and found many, many invertebrates which really enhance their learning. We are so thankful to The Rhea Farm for allowing us to use the area. Ospreys are looking forward to going again next half term!
