Apologies for not getting the newsletter out to you on Friday. We have had some staff illness lately meaning that there has been a lot of "pitching in" where needed and I literally ran out of time!

PIPITS CLASSROOM - NEW PLANS

Some of you may have spotted the plans that have been displayed in one of the noticeboards in the lane between the main building and the playground.

As you can see, the new build will be a very similar style, in keeping with the local environment, so there will be very little impact on the overall look of the school.

Internally we have been able to have some input with the layout, ensuring that there are low-level toilets for the children and also a regular size toilet for adult use. There will be low-level sinks for the children and a normal height sink for adults to use. There will also be a small internal room which can be used for a multitude of different purposes: group work; assessments where a quiet area is best and calm space for children if they are feeling poorly or distressed. This will really enhance the provision we have for our youngest learners.

MORNING ROUTINE

Please could I just remind parents and carers when dropping off in the morning to allow your child, or children, to come in to the school on their own. Members of the teaching team are not available to talk to you in the mornings as they are providing learning activities for the children from the moment they arrive. If you need to pass information on to the teacher, please let the office know and they will pass on the message to the class teacher.

NEIGHBOURS

I would also like to remind all those dropping off and collecting children that School Lane is the entrance to use when walking from Kilmington Village. Anyone arriving by vehicle should be parking in one of the two large car parks by the Village Hall and Baptist Church and approaching the school through the church yard. All our neighbours are friendly and supportive of the school but this issue has been raised by them AGAIN which puts me in an awkward position. We really should be more mindful of not causing nuisance to our neighbours. Also, we MUST consider those walking from the village who need to cross the road at the junction, as visibility is virtually non-existent when it is clogged up by cars everywhere.

You will have also noticed that the neighbours have scaffolding up and are having structural work done so even more care needs to be taken in this area.
