ATTENDANCE

I am pleased to say that whole school attendance for the period September – December was 94.4% which is slightly up on the data from September - October half term. This still falls marginally short of our target however so there is further room for improvement. We still have 13 cases of attendance that falls below 90% and while a handful of these are special cases (allowances made for special educational needs such as part-time timetables) this is still quite a high number for such a small school.

Unfortunately we have had an awful lot of bugs going round this half term, so I do have a feeling that the data for September – February may well have dropped again. I will keep you informed once I have analysed the data later on in the month.

MANNERS

Nearly all the teachers in the school have been chatting about some of the ways that we hear children speaking to each other. Every class has an agreement to be kind, helpful and respectful to others but we have all had to have circle times based around kind words, politeness and general courteousness. Some children are becoming quite "bossy" and getting involved in each other's business quite a lot which causes grumbles and arguments. We are trying to explain that while it is kind to be helpful to our friends, the tone and manner in which we offer this help can sometimes come across in quite a rude and unpleasant manner.

I know that we can all slip up a bit with this but could we please ask that you continue this theme at home: if your child speaks their siblings or yourselves in such a way, could you have a discussion around how their tone comes across. Working together like this will reinforce the expectations for our children and hopefully be conducive to a more pleasant environment for everyone.
