
What you can do to help at home:

Science

and creating pieces of abstract art using shape and colour.


In Design and Technology, we will be designing and making a healthy wrap to link with our learning about food in Geography and Science.

In English, we will have our usual daily phonics sessions to improve reading and writing skills. Adult led reading groups will take place three times a week. presented. We will be writing our own questions and information text about an animal of our choice. We will also be improving handwriting, grammar, punctuation and spelling skills.

Computing

We will be looking at algorithms and the importance of accurate instructions in computing. We will also be learning some word processing skills such as typing, changing the font, spell check and saving work.
