Dear Parents

Hopefully you will have all had a chance to read the letter and associated report from our recent inspection, which is now live on the Ofsted website. We will be working as a team on the areas for improvement, with support from the wider federation team. We continue to be extremely appreciative of the support that we receive from our parent community which was mentioned several times in the feedback that we received.

STATUTORY ASSESSMENTS

Over the next couple of months we have various statutory assessments happening, starting with the Year 6 SATs that start in the week commencing 13th May. Year 1 will do a phonics check and Year 4 have a multiplication check. Alongside these we use standardised tests within classes to assess children against National standards; to check their understanding of their current learning and see any gaps and/or misunderstandings that need addressing.

CHURCHYARD

Over the last few weeks we have seen a decline in behaviour while accessing the school via the churchyard path. The church path was put in to help the school with access but is not owned by the school. When walking through the churchyard as a class we teach the children to respect the area by walking nicely, on the path, not running across the grass and not walking on graves. Before and after school however we have seen children running around all over the grass and graves and even climbing the trees. As part of Kilmington village we need to be mindful of the community areas at all times. I would ask that you reinforce these standards both before and after school.
