Key Learning: Questions and answers; grouping data; creating and structuring a database; data collection; analysing data; presenting data.

History

Ancient Greece

Key Learning: life in early Greece; trading; life in Athens and Sparta; overcoming the Persian invasion and life afterwards; King Phillip II and the Macedon Empire; Alexander the Great; the greatest achievements of Ancient Greece.

Key Learning:

Balanced lifestyle and diet; influences on our choices; good hygiene practises; acceptable and unacceptable physical touch; consent; secrets; enterprise.

Key learning: The difference between water colour paint and acrylic paint; the role of and illustrator; understanding how illustrations can help people; talking about illustrations

Key Learning: Understanding light sources; reflective light; the dangers of the sun; shadows; changing shadows with light position; how mirrors work.

Key Learning: Evaluate fastenings, design to product specifications, create and use a paper template, sew two pieces of fabric together to create a book sleeve.

Geography

Investigating weather and climate

Key Learning: Understanding the difference between weather and climate; ways to collect, record, present and evaluate weather data.

RE

What do Hindus believe God is like?

Key Learning: ultimate reality; idea of Brahman and daily living; some Hindu deities and how many Hindus understand them; Ganesh; Hindu beliefs about God.

What does it mean to be a Hindu in Britain today?

Key Learning; Hindu Dharma; understanding how and why about Puja; the story of King Yudhishtira; Ramayana; Diwali celebrations.
