Computing 1

Creating media - Digital Writing

Key learning: Exploring the keyboard; adding and removing text; exploring the toolbar; making changes to text; explaining choices; answering the question pencil, or keyboard?

DT

Mechanisms - Making a moving story book

Key Learning: Exploring simple mechanisms; recognising where mechanisms exist in familiar products; design and create a moving picture for a story; evaluate the finished product.

Key Learning: How does music make us feel?; rhythms and patterns; how music can be used; notes and tempo; creating digital music; reviewing and editing music.

Science 2

Animals including humans

Key Learning: Knowing what humans need; knowing what offspring are; learning how animals change as they grow into adults; thinking about whether we all grow the same; thinking about diet and exercise; learning about the importance of good hygiene and how to feel better when we are ill.

Outdoor Learning

Kingfishers will be going to outdoor learning in the first half of the Spring Term. We try to link our sessions to our wider curriculum.

History

Hospital and Healthcare

Key Learning: thinking about how we can find out about the past; learning who Florence Nightingale and Edith Cavell are and why they are significant; learning about how the past has been represented; thinking about how Florence and Edith have changed our hospitals.

RE 1

Who is Muslim and how do they live? (2)

Key Learning: thinking about the Prophet Muhammad and why he is important to Muslims; the difference that worshipping god makes to Muslims and what it means in their lives.

RE 2

What is the "good news" Christians believe Jesus brings? (1)
Key Learning: Learning about the significance of Matthew and retelling his story; understanding forgiveness and what it means; thinking about who needs the peace of Jesus; understanding how Christians follow the life of Jesus and learning about how they spread the Good News.

PSHE

Key Learning: Where money comes from, what it's for and why it is important; the things needed for a healthy lifestyle; the importance of handwashing and personal hygiene. Road safety rules; what to do in a fire; staying safe on a walk; understanding change and loss, and the feelings with that.

Music

Whole Class Tuition: Ocarina
Being Baggy: Introducing the ocarina; learning the notes B - A - G. Football: composing melodies; performing patterns; writing own word patterns.
