History

Technology

Key Learning: how can we find out about the past?; thinking about how technology has changed how we write, talk and are entertained; learning about the important inventors in the history of technology; understanding how technology has changed our lives over the last 60 years.

PSHE

Key Learning: Special people; personal space; comfortable vs uncomfortable; the difference between teasing and bullying; changes as we grow older; understanding baby teeth; how to keep my teeth clean; what is a dentist; helping someone who is sick or injured; learning from experiences.

Geography

My Local Area and...

Key learning: Using atlases and globes to look at the continents and oceans, poles, equator; learning about the countries, capital cities and surrounding seas of the UK; the key human and physical features of the local area, including aerial photographs and comparing the similarities and differences to another place.

Computing 1

Programming B - Animations

Key learning: Comparing tools; joining blocks of code; making a change; adding sprites; thinking about the design of my project; following my design.

Science 2

Animals including humans

Key Learning: Understanding what a plant is and what the parts of a plant are called; understanding that plants grow; learning about wild plants in our local area; understanding how we can group plants; thinking about plants we can and cannot eat; thinking about trees - are they plants?; learning about leaves.

RE 1

Why does Easter matter to Christians?

Key Learning: thinking about the main events of Easter; explaining the main events of Easter; understanding which events are happy and which are sad; learning the definition of sin and salvation; understanding what is secular and what is religious; recap and assessment.

RE 2

What is the "good news" Christians believe Jesus brings? (2)
Key Learning: Learning about Hannah Dunnett and what she does; producing art showing some Good News; understanding prayer; learning about the Lord's Prayer; thinking about how people share the Good News; recap and assessment.

Music

The Rockpool Song: 2 part singing; rock and roll structure; timbre; introduction to song and style of rock and roll. Tanczomy Labada: singing games; traditional Polish dances; follow a changing beat and tempo; percussion accompaniment and body percussion.

Online Safety

Key Learning: Being SMART online, and exploring life online with the help of Smartie the Penguin.

PE

Key Learning (alongside the Leap into Life programme): Functional movement; movement concepts; aesthetic movement; manipulative skills.

DT

Cooking and Nutrition: Balanced diet, making wraps

Key Learning: Recognise food and their groups; identify the balance of food groups in a meal; preparing ingredients; taste testing combinations; plan a recipe; create and evaluate waps.
